President: Mert Mischnick talked about the fun fly competition between our club and the Propmasters. This year they will be hosting the event, but what the event will be, is our choice. We would like to make a decision before spring so members can prepare and practice. We are looking for event suggestions. (Jeff Peca has already put his vote in for the Wiffle Ball Touch and Go).

Mert was also looking for volunteers to make coffee and bring the doughnuts to the meeting. Ray Rohde has been bringing doughnuts and volunteered to continue. Thanks Ray!!

Vice President: Steve Dietrich said the door prize was a cordless soldering iron. In addition, Jerry Jeske has been cleaning house and brought in a completed RV-4 model with OS 40 FP engine that he donated as an additional door prize. A big thank you to Jerry for his very generous gift.

There were some opinions expressed at the Board meeting that our logo was difficult to read, so it was suggested we consider making some changes to the logo. After some discussion, Orvil Fluharty made a motion to have a competition for a new logo. Entries would be submitted at the February meeting and reviewed and judged by the members. The designer of the winning logo will be given a jacket with his handiwork adorned on it. The motion was seconded and approved by the members.

Scott also had some event flyers and was looking for some help to distribute them.

SPAD Fest: Scott Hurley also talked about SPAD Fest being held in Des Moines, Iowa this year. Early registration fee for the event is \$20 and he would like to see a good turn out to show our support.

Swap Shop: Debbie Howe talked about the club swap shop that will be held on Saturday, April 7th. The swap will be held at the fairgrounds, but there was a problem with the room reservation. Because of that, we will not have the building we usually have, we will have half of the large building. One half will be our show and the other half will be a cat show (from 10am-3pm). Toledo will be the week after our swap, which should be to our benefit. Set up will be on Friday from 4pm-5pm.

Debbie also discussed the raffle. There was some discussion about having the usual cash prize raffle or having a 50%-50% raffle instead. It was finally decided to try the 50-50 this year.
