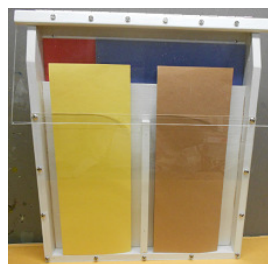
Paul Kramer had a presentation on motor KV data.
