Manville Field Report - Kurt Krempetz

Discussion points:

- The walking path around the field has not been an issue due to low foot traffic, however, the entire field has been tilled and native plants and prairie grass will be planted this fall. The West Chicago Park District has offered four other sites that could be used as flying fields. Members of SRCB as well as other non members have walked the fields and determined that the existing Manville field would be best at this time. There may be some possible flying sites outside of the West Chicago Park District and Kurt and Bob Sarley will continue to investigate.

Treasurer Report – Kurt Krempetz

Discussion points:

- Kurt gave an update of the 2025 financials. We currently have \$5257.23. There have been no new members since our last meeting.

Flight Stands at PWW

Discussion points:

- Bob Vance confirmed that the DuPage County Forest Preserve had the flight stands installed. Based on this we discussed who would be responsible for maintaining the stands and how to approach the forest preserve. Bob Sulla recommended that take a direct approach and have a conversation with the person in charge of the field or attend a DuPage Forest Preserve board meeting to bring up the subject. For members that live in DuPage county, it would be advantageous to contact your representative. Sandy will dig into the issue and find out who is directly in charge of the fields and make contact.

Tee Shirts and Hats - David Bella

Discussion points:

- David Bella said he could get a digital design through a relative free of charge. Wally will get the club's screens to David so each option can be considered. Other factors such as material or a new design will be discussed at our next meeting.
- Kurt pointed out that a quantity of 50 shirts or hats may be the break even point for the cost per shirt/hat. The art work in a digital format may need to be upgraded to sharpen the club logo.
